The 20th European Economics Education Conference is an international meeting of teachers, teacher trainers, inspectors and researchers with a professional interest in all aspects of Economics, Social Sciences and Business Education in Europe and worldwide. In **Aix en Provence (France)** during the **AEEE Conference 2014** on economics education you will:

Theme

The 20th Conference builds upon Manchester (2010) and Kohn (2012), where the themes also related to the prolonged international crisis. "Teaching Economics in a Europe in crisis" is the main thread of the conference in 2014, but the perspective is both distinct and complementary. In Manchester, it deals with "economy after the global crisis". In Kohn the question was: "the economic crisis – catastrophe or opportunity?" This time, the question will be rather: "why has the crisis been prolonged?", and: "how has the crisis differed between and within societies?". The focus will be on the various manifestations of the crisis, its impact on both the economy and the society and the implications for different levels of education.

We welcome contributions offering a range of perspectives: economics, social sciences and business, social, environmental and sustainable development. The conference will offer the following formats: plenary lectures, round table discussions and workshops.

In all AEEE conferences there is a strong emphasis on sharing classroom experiences, pedagogy and teaching in economics, social sciences and business education among teachers from different countries in Europe and beyond. We welcome both contributions on the central theme of the crisis, but also on other current developments which are relevant to teachers of Economics working in a variety of curriculum contexts. Comparisons will be made between the European systems of teaching economics, business and other social sciences as well as on teachings on the environment and the sustainable development, but also on teachers training. We hope to provide an opportunity to examine the contributions of various social sciences to understanding the ongoing crisis.

The languages of the conference will be English and French – translation will be provided.
